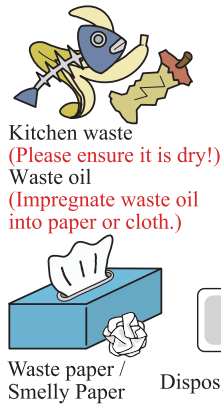

### ◆ Burnable garbage day

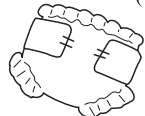

Only bag waste will come out.  
Use a crow repellent net.

(Please ensure it is dry!)

(Impregnate waste oil into paper or cloth.)



Please remove waste ranspare from disposable diapers and wrap them in paper.



Stuffed toys  
(< 40 cm)

(cut into pieces less than 40 cm)



Aluminum foil

(Metal parts → can, metals)

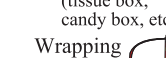
Containers and packaging with a "plastic mark" that do not come clean even with a light rinse (less than 40 cm)

(wet with water)



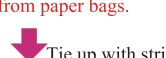
Plastic products without a "plastic mark" (< 40 cm)



Please tie the top of the bag tightly before putting out.



Use a transparent or semi-transparent bag



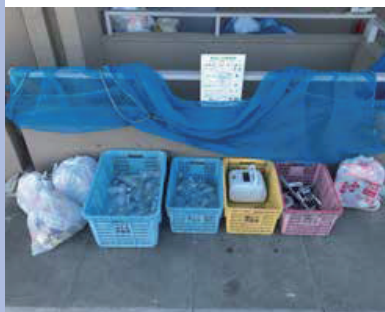
Please cut twigs and branches to less than 40 cm in length and tie with string. Up to 5cm thick.

### ◆ Non-burnable garbage day

Weekly on



Four types of baskets are used. There is also bag waste (Plastic mark containers and packaging, miscellaneous paper, hazardous materials).

#### Plastic bottles

- Items marked "PET"
- Beverages
- Alcohol
- Seasonings

Refrain from taking them out on days with strong winds.

① Make sure you remove to the cap.

- Plastic caps
- Plastic containers and packaging

② Peel off the label.

- Plastic mark containers and packaging (Paper labels are burnable garbage)

③ Lightly wash the inside with water.

④ Crush the bottle

⑤ Put bottles in a blue basket (large/small) without putting it in a bag.

Please take any bags you use for bringing things out back with you

Recycling

#### Plastic mark containers and packaging

- Items marked
- Plastic bags, candy bags, frozen food bags
- Bottles (except PET bottles)
- Styrofoam, food trays

※ Lightly rinse to remove dirt.

Use a transparent or semi-transparent bag

Please do not put one bag inside another

Items without a or items that cannot be cleaned by lightly rinsing

#### Miscellaneous paper (other papers)

(Newspapers, cardboard, magazines, shredder garbage, item other than paper cartons)

Remove the contents from the envelope and sort them.

Envelopes

Paper box (tissue box, candy box, etc.)

Wrapping paper

Postcards

Paper boxes should be cut open.

Remove cloth twine and metal fittings from paper bags.

Tie up with string

Use a transparent or semi-transparent bag (paper bag also OK)

Items with stains, shopping receipts and thermal paper, items with odors (such as incense or detergent boxes)

#### Hazardous items

Secondary batteries (lithium-ion, nickel-metal hydride, nickel-cadmium)

Small home appliances (less than 40cm) with non-removable secondary batteries

Secondary batteries should be insulated. Put them in separate bags.

Use a transparent bag

Lithium-ion batteries

※ For items that may expand and ignite, contact the Environmental Div.

Dry batteries, button batteries, lighters

Use up. Place in separate bags.

Use a transparent or semi-transparent bag

Use a transparent or semi-transparent bag

※ Insulate button batteries with cellophane tape.

Thermometers, blood pressure monitors, fluorescent tubes

It is acceptable for the fluorescent tube to stick out of the bag.

Do not put it in the box

Recycling (Partial disposal)

#### Non-combustible items

Tape broken items to prevent them from scattering. Put finely broken items in bags. And write 'waremono'.

Chinaware and glass

Mirrors

Small home appliances (Less than 40cm, without rechargeable batteries)

Wire hanger

Umbrella

Example

- telephone
- hair dryer
- Spoon, fork

Please wrap dangerous items in paper.

Put them straight in the yellow or red basket, do not put them in a bag first.

Fire extinguishers and batteries

Take it out without putting it in a bag. (Even if the contents remain)

※ For home use only

※ Lead-acid battery only

### ◆ Recyclable garbage day

Weekly on



Four types of baskets are used. Paper (other than shredder waste) is tied with string. Remove cloths and shredded waste in separate bags.

#### Cans ; metal items

Lightly wash the inside before taking it out.

Empty cans (Steel cans, aluminum cans, etc.)

Pot

Stainless steel bottle

Remove the rubber and plastic parts.

Frying pan

Tea containers, candy cans

Other Metal

- Copper
- Stainless steel
- Brass

Put items in the blue basket (large). Put them straight in; do not put them in a bag first

Please take any bags you use for bringing things out back with you

Blue basket (large)

Items over 40 cm → Oversized garbage

A mixture that contains materials other than metal → Non-burnable garbage

Recycling

#### Spray cans, gas cylinders for portable cooking stoves, spray type fire extinguishers

If the contents remain, there is a risk of explosion in collection vehicles.

No need to puncture the can.

Use up the contents completely outdoors in a well-ventilated area away from fire. Use a gas removal cap, or if not available, spray it on a newspaper, etc.

Put items in the yellow basket. Put them straight in; do not put them in a bag first

#### Fabrics

~ Please refrain from putting out garbage if it is raining ~

E.g.) Shirts, trousers, jeans, socks, underwear, coats, sweaters, sheets, yarn, towels, futon covers (zipper removed)

[The futon is oversized garbage.]

Use a transparent or semi-transparent bag (paper bag also OK)

Cloth items that cannot be recycled

Stuffed with cotton or feathers, 40cm or more: Futon, Kotatsu futon, mattress pad, bed pad, hot carpet cover, kitchen mat

→ Oversized garbage

Stuffed with cotton or feathers less than 40cm: Down jacket (cut into pieces less than 40 cm)

→ Burnable garbage

#### Paper

Divide according to the five types shown below.

Please tie these up with free paper twine distributed by the city.

Newspapers, flyers

Cardboard

Tie each with string

Magazines, books, notebooks, dictionaries (Bound publication)

Tie with a string

Paper cartons

Tie with a string

Open these cut, rinse with water and dry before putting out.

A paper pack that has silver paper stuck on the inside → Burnable garbage

Shredded paper (Paper only)

Make sure the garbage bag is properly sealed.

Use a transparent or semi-transparent bag (paper bag also OK)

#### Bottles

Please lightly wash the inside before putting out.

Reusable bottles

Reusable after washing. (returnable)

Item with this mark

Beer bottles, 1-sho bottles (1.8 l), etc. Remove the cap.

Put items in the red basket. Put them straight in; do not put them in a bag first

Assorted bottles

Non-returnable glass bottles. (one-way bottles)

Blue basket (small)

Remove the cap.

Put items in the blue basket (small). Put them straight in; do not put them in a bag first

### Basics Points of put out the garbage

#### Basics of put out the garbage 1

Empty plastic bottles, plastic containers and packaging, cans and bottles should be emptied and lightly rinsed or wiped to reduce contamination. (It will also prevent odors when stored at home)

#### Basics of put out the garbage 2

Garbage and leftover food should be drained and placed inside a garbage bag so that crows with good vision Please put it in the garbage bag so that crows can't see it. (It is effective to wrap it with other burnable garbage)

#### Basics of put out the garbage 3

Garbage is sorted by type and collected according to the region. Please put it out by 8:00 AM on each day of the week. This is called [sorted disposal]. Garbage that has not been sorted out will not be collected.



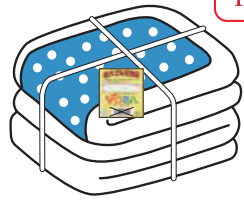
# ◆ Oversized garbage

Items with a side length of 40 cm or more.  
Advance application is required.

**Paid (400 yen per item)**  
**Must apply in advance.**



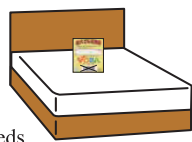
You can apply for up to 10 items at a time. With LINE applications, you can choose the collection date from the dates shown.

(1 set = up to a maximum of 2)



Zabutons  
(1 set = up to 5 of the same item)



Beds  
(Bunk beds: each tier counts as 1 item, ladder as 1 item, under-bed dresser as 1 item)

Pillows  
(1 set = up to a maximum of 2)



Chairs  
(1 set = up to 1)

Oil stove  
(Remove oil from the tank)

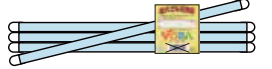

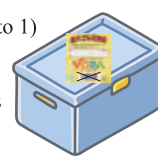

(Set counts as 1 item; up to 14 clubs)

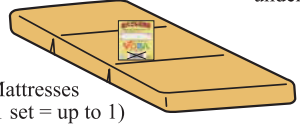

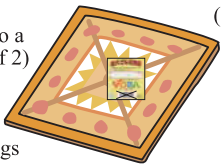

## Telephone application

Please note that the line is extremely busy on Mondays, after holidays, and during the year-end/New Year period.

### ● Oversized garbage service ☎048-424-5747 (Representative)

For additions or changes, be sure to contact us by the morning of the day before collection.  
(If the day before collection falls on a Sunday, public holiday, or between December 29 and January 3, contact us by the day prior to that.)

### ● Line Opens: Mon–Fri 8:30–17:15 / Sat 9:00–13:00

(Closed on Sundays, public holidays, and December 29–January 3)

※ For each over size garbage you applied for, you must attach one

[Over size garbage Collection Ticket (400 yen)] per item.

※ Write your name (or reception number) and collection date on the ticket.

## LINE application

Choose a collection date from the selectable dates.

You must have the LINE app installed on your smartphone, be registered with the Toda City official LINE account, and have the ability to make electronic payments via PayPay (available from mid-April 2025) or credit card.

- You can choose the collection date (there is a limit on the number of applications per day).
- Payment is by PayPay (available from mid-April 2025) or credit card only. (Collection tickets are not accepted.)
- Choose from registered items (if your item is not listed, consult by phone).

# ◆ Garbage the city cannot collect (cannot be processed by the city)

## ◆ Disposal method: Contact the store where purchased or a licensed waste disposal contractor.

※ Waste generated during home renovation or remodeling must be collected by the construction contractor. (Includes built-in appliances replaced by yourself.)

※ For home medical waste, consult your medical institution or pharmacy.

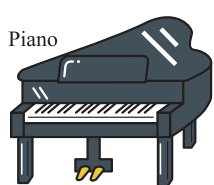

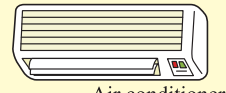
## Business waste

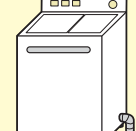

# ◆ Key points for separate disposal (for commonly generated garbage)

## How to dispose of PET bottles.



1 Remove caps and labels.



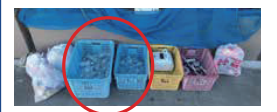
2 Rinse lightly.



3 Check for remaining dirt.



4 Crush and place directly into the blue basket on "Non-burnable Garbage Day".



Items that cannot be cleaned should be placed out on "Burnable Garbage Day".

## How to dispose of plastic-mark containers/wrapping.



1 Use up the contents or eat as much as possible.



2 Rinse lightly or wipe clean.



3 Check for remaining dirt.



4 Put in a transparent or semi-transparent bag and put out on "Non-burnable Garbage Day".



Items that cannot be cleaned should be placed out on "Burnable Garbage Day".

## How to dispose of kitchen waste, cooking scraps, and leftovers.

1 Try to consume food before its expiration date.



2 Drain well using a net or strainer.



3 Take measures to hide from crows (wrap with other burnable garbage, etc.).



4 Put in a transparent or semi-transparent bag and put out on "Burnable Garbage Day".
